THE CHURCH OF PENTECOST-YOUTH MINISTRY GUIDELINES FOR THE 2017 PENTECOST WRITERS CONTEST

PREAMBLE

The Pentecost Writers Contest is an annual contest organized by the Youth Ministry to unearth the talents of members of the Church, both youth and adults, who have the flair for writing. Out of the scripts submitted each year, the best are selected for publication in an annual Youth Reader.

PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES FOR THE 2017 CONTEST

The following shall apply for the 2017 Contest:

Opening:

The contest shall officially open on TUESDAY, 7TH FEBRUARY, 2017 after an opening declaration by the leadership of the Church.

Registration

Interested persons shall register after the official opening. Registration forms could be retrieved from www.thecophq.org and www.penteagle.org. The forms could be downloaded, filled and submitted to the Writers Committee via pentwriterscontest@gmail.com. Applicants can also register by filling a registration form (hard copy) to be circulated by the Youth Directorate through any of the Youth Ministry offices from the National to the Assembly level. The filled forms must be forwarded to The National Coordinating Committee, Pentecost Writers' Contest, Youth Ministry Directorate, P. O. Box 2194, Accra. Registration shall be FREE. In filling the form, writers shall indicate their topics of interest for the contest. Such topic(s) should be chosen from the five thematic areas of Spirituality, Social Life, Health, Academics and National Development.

SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES

Applicants must submit their articles latest by 30 June, 2017. An applicant may submit more than one script provided they are not within the same thematic area. Articles may reach the Writers Contest Committee through pentwriterscontest@gmail.com. All articles submitted after the stipulated date shall be rejected.

Marking of scripts and Discussions by Committee: JULY 2017

Oral Defense: 9TH SEPTEMBER at 1:00PM.

External Assessment: OCTOBER

Publishing of selected articles in a reader: NOVEMBER.

Declaration of Winner, Receiving of Awards and Launching of Reader: January 2018 (during the PENSA National Conference)

ASSESSMENT OF SCRIPTS

Scripts would be marked by the National Youth Writers' Contest Committee. Areas for consideration would include how rich and sound the arguments propelled are in dealing with the topic being written on. In addition, the laws that govern essay writing in English Language

would be uncompromisingly employed. The writer's ability to sustain the interest of the youth and his readers at large will be a plus.

Marking Scheme

Content - 30 marks

Organisation - 10 marks

Expression - 20 marks

Mechanical Accuracy - 20 marks
Originality of thought - 20 marks

The marks obtained by each participant would be converted to over seventy while the oral defense would be graded over thirty, making hundred in all.

ORAL DEFENSE

Writers of the best ten scripts submitted would be invited for an Oral Defense Session to defend their work.
